Our neighbourhood teams continue to lead the way across Cheshire, with shoplifting detection rates now exceeding 60% for 2026 – far above the national average and a testament to the hard work of officers and partners. We are making Cheshire as hostile as possible for prolific offenders, securing Criminal Behaviour Orders wherever appropriate to protect our communities. We remain fully committed to tackling ASB across all areas, and the recent uplift in neighbourhood officers means you will see more patrols, more visibility, and more officers on foot in our local communities. You Said, We Did



Crewe Central —BB01

You Said: You would like to see an increase in police visibility in the Town Centre due to youths causing anti social behavior, as a result leaving you feeling vulnerable and not wanting to come into the Town Centre.

We Did: Weekly visits with the Safer Streets Van on the Lyceum Square and the Grand Junction Retail Park, offering reassurance, bike marking, promoting the Hollie Guard App.

Crewe Central—BB01

You Said: Fly-tipping is becoming an increased issue

We Did: We conducted foot patrol across Crewe Central and have reported a number of fly tipping incidents to the council. We have also ensured that alley gates have been shut and advised local residents on best ways to report any further incidents.

Crewe St Barnabus—BB02

You Said: There are issues with Anti-social Behaviour and youths setting fires in the wooded area of Leighton Brook Park.

We Did: To combat this we have conducted beat walks with the local councillor and liaised with CCTV operators in the area to try and identify offenders. Hi-visibility patrols deter anti-social behaviour and prevent the issues that have been identified.

Crewe West—BB03

You Said: ASB, Parking, Drug dealing, Cyclists

We Did: Officers have been on hi-visibility patrol across the hotspots identified primarily around Flag Lane and Valley park to deter ASB. Additional partnership working has taken place to engage the YMCA outreach team to give young people somewhere to go. There have been several Fixed Penalty Notices served for illegal parking across the ward. Officers have conducted plain clothes operations around hotspots for drug dealing to identify offenders.

Lastly surgeries have been ran where bike marking and bike safety has been addressed with a number of cyclists provided with lights so they are visible on the roads.
