Our neighbourhood teams continue to lead the way across Cheshire, with shoplifting detection rates now exceeding 60% for 2026 – far above the national average and a testament to the hard work of officers and partners. We remain fully committed to tackling ASB across all areas, and the recent uplift in neighbourhood officers means you will see more patrols, more visibility, and more officers on foot in our local communities. You Said, We Did



Crewe East

You Said: There has been an increase in ASB and Thefts around the Grand Junction Retail Park.

We Did: Your officers are completing engagement sessions in the area, there has been an increase of foot patrols, a number of arrests have been made where those charged have been given banning orders to prevent them from operating in the area. This work will continue for next few months.

Leighton

You Said: There's been an increase in ASB around the shops on Parkers Road

We Did: Your Officers have conducted regular patrols and worked with the shops, those who have been identified are engaging with Police and Cheshire East Councils ASB team, further issues are being addressed with engagement and education through our schools. Your officers are supporting with this work.

Crewe North

You Said: Parking Concerns around Singleton Avenue/Broad Street with vehicles causing obstruction and concerns around safety.

We Did: Your neighborhood policing team has increased patrols in the area, particularly during peak times when issues are most commonly reported. Officers have been engaging with drivers and taking enforcement action when necessary. We are continuing to monitor the situation and will carry out further patrols.

Haslington

You Said: We don't see Police enough in the area

We Did: Your Local Officer, is working with local businesses to ensure the village has regular engagement opportunities with them, we are also looking at how we can make sure we are conducting foot patrols in key areas during the lighter months
