Complaints about speeding

You Said: There are too many vehicles speeding in the area around Knutsford.

We Did: Through our Resident's Voice, speeding is again one of the top priorities that we are asked to tackle, with Knutsford town centre and the surrounding estates being the primary areas of note. Speeding is taken seriously and we here at Knutsford will take any and all opportunities to ensure the safety of road users and pedestrians alike. This quarter a total of **403** vehicles were caught speeding through the use of our Trucam device and our static Camera Van, with each driver either receiving a Speed Awareness Course, points on their license, or a postal requisition to attend court. Think about your speed and drive carefully!

ASB in Knutsford Town Centre

You Said: There are instances of crime and ASB in and around Knutsford Town Centre, including Moor Park and the Heath.

We Did: Whilst we haven't had an increase in reports of ASB we are always conscious that nice weather can affect this. Throughout Spring and Summer we will be conducting Cops on the Square throughout Knutsford; actively patrolling the area and being a visible deterrent to anti-social behaviour. As well as this, we will be conducting the same surgeries in and around the town whereby you can approach and talk to our staff at your leisure— please see the below list of dates, times, and locations.

Pickmere Lake

You Said: We are worried about parking issues and drugs at Pickmere Lake

We Did: We have been working closely with our partners at the Highways Agency, Cheshire East Council, and Pickmere Parish Council, as well as others, in order to solve this yearly problem. Whilst we aren't in a position to detail the confirm the plans in place, please rest assured that we are working to help create a sustainable solution to a problem that has been plaguing residents for many years. Further to this, we understand that good weather can at times entice those with drugs to attend the lake— we will be attending the lake, both in uniform and in covert clothes, throughout the summer and anyone found with such drugs will be dealt with robustly.
