### Cheshire Constabulary Performance Update: January 2026 - March 2026

Figures are compared to the same period in 2025

#### Response



**4 seconds** - the average time to answer emergency calls.

**93%** of emergency incidents attended in **15 minutes** Up **1%**

**93%** of prompt incidents attended in **60 minutes** Up **6%**

Compared to **6 seconds** in the same period last year.

#### Crime and Incidents

**18,489** crimes recorded up by **3%**

**51,308** incidents reported **Stayed the same**

**5,011** arrests made up by **8%**

**Domestic Abuse Offences** brought to justice **26%** up by **4%**

**Sexual offences** brought to justice **19%** up by **7%**

**All crime offences** brought to justice **26%** up by **4%**

## You Said, We Did



### Macclesfield Central

**You Said:** Issues with Anti-social behavior in the town centre and shoplifting.

**We Did:** We have been patrolling the areas, doing stop searches, enforcing the Public space protection orders making arrests and applying for criminal behavior orders.

### Macclesfield South

**You Said:** Shoplifting and Parking

**We Did:** . Officers have been doing parking patrol in the area and working with partner agencies. Officers have also had reports in relation to anti-social behavior on the area called "Yellow Brick Road" near to Congleton Road, Macclesfield. They have and will continue to patrol the area and work with partner agencies to address the matters and make it a safer area.

### Broken Cross

**You Said:** Anti-social behavior in the Westmorland Close area.

**We Did:** We are regularly patrolling the area and working with the community to tackle these issues.

### Macclesfield West and Ivy

**You Said:** Anti-social behavior– Weston Skate Park

**We Did:** Why is this area a priority: This area is a priority due to ASB caused by youths on the park, the youths use this location to congregate and cause issues for members of the public- especially during half-term. There is also drug dealing which takes place at this location so by conducting high visibility this reduces it from happening.

### Macclesfield East and Sutton

**You Said:** Issues with anti-social behavior (Macc East) Rural– Speeding issues in rural locations.

**We Did:** Regular patrols in Macclesfield east, stop searches and working with partner agencies to make Macclesfield East a safer place and to stop alcohol-related anti-social behavior.

I have also been conducting Speed enforcement in the rural areas, following complaints about speeding and traffic.
