Cheshire Constabulary Performance Update: January 2026 - March 2026

Figures are compared to the same period in 2025

Response



4 seconds - the average time to answer emergency calls.

93% of emergency incidents attended in **15 minutes** Up **1%**

93% of prompt incidents attended in **60 minutes** Up **6%**

Compared to **6 seconds** in the same period last year.

Crime and Incidents

18,489 crimes recorded up by **3%**

51,308 incidents reported **Stayed the same**

5,011 arrests made up by **8%**

Domestic Abuse Offences brought to justice **26%** up by **4%**

Sexual offences brought to justice **19%** up by **7%**

As we move into the warmer months, Warrington Neighbourhood Policing will continue to focus on the key issues residents have raised: **road safety, anti, social behaviour, and drug related crime.**

Following a recent restructure, we now have an **increased number of officers dedicated to neighbourhood policing, including a dedicated officer working with partners and schools to address anti-social behaviour.**

In line with the Neighbourhood Policing Guarantee, more officers are back on the beat, our **Town Centre Team has been strengthened to support local businesses,** and we continue to take firm action against the illegal and anti-social use of off road bikes.

You said ... Can you do something about the Fly tipping issues, abandoned vehicles and the general state of Vulcan & Valiant estate

We did ... We are collaborating with the Council, Torus Housing, and the local MP to address the root causes of issues on this estate. A new Residents Association has been formed to ensure those most affected have a regular voice.

Police presence has increased, including plain-clothed patrols, and several vehicles have already been removed. Your local PCSO is committed to finding long-term solutions rather than temporary fixes. This remains an ongoing priority until residents are satisfied with the results.

You said ... can you do something about the rise in push bike thefts

We did ... We're actively investigating bike thefts in Warrington, reviewing CCTV and sharing images with all officers. Protect your bike by attending our free marking events—find dates on Cheshire Alerts or Facebook. Marking deters thieves and helps us return your property if it's ever stolen and recovered.

You said ... Do something about the e-scooters and off-road bikes

We did ... We are mapping illegal bike activity and using plain-clothes officers to seize vehicles and prosecute uninsured, unlicensed riders. We're also targeting e-scooters and using social media to locate where these bikes are stored. We will continue working robustly to remove these culprits from our streets.
