Throughout the Winter, we will continue to focus on the key community issues you have highlighted to us: **Road Safety**, **Anti-Social Behaviour (ASB)**, and **Drug-Related Crime**. These remain our community's primary concerns, and our teams are dedicated to taking action to address these issues. We are committed to working tirelessly to keep our communities safe.

You can follow your local neighbourhood teams on social media for the latest updates and changes. In the last few months of the year, we launched several operations tackling ASB which included our continued focus on those who commit ASB using off Road and E Bikes. In December **Operation Jingles**, supported making our towns even safer. Our focus included:

- **Anti-Social Behaviour (ASB)**
- **Crime and Enforcement involving retail crime**
- **Diversion and Support**
- **Visibility and Engagement tackling violence against Woman and Girls (VAWG)**

We have also rolled out our winter youth engagement programme, which tackles key issues and focuses on keeping children safe. This programme supports diversionary initiatives in collaboration with youth services. In Warrington, we have strong partnership support and will continue to work together to address these key issues.

You Said, We Did



Warrington Town Centre

You said....Issues of Anti-Social Behaviour in the Town Centre caused by Street Drinkers resulting in shops losing business.

We Did... Targeted high visibility and plain clothes patrols in identified hotspot areas, using intelligence led policing and local knowledge to deploy resources effectively.

We are actively confiscating alcohol, using dispersal and stop search powers where lawful and proportionate, and taking positive action for ASB and public order offences. This has included issuing Community Resolutions (CRs), summoning suspects for drug offences, and making arrests for hate related and domestic abuse incidents.

We are targeting persistent offenders, we have just successfully been granted a CBO on the highest repeat individual, and we are progressing a Public Space Protection Order. Partnership work continues with CCTV, Community Safety, Licensing and the Homeless Outreach Team to both enforce and support vulnerable individuals.

Regular patrols take place at key locations to deter crime and build public confidence. PC Yeadon has led on obtaining a Public Space Protection Order, which has been agreed and is awaiting council finalisation. This will give more powers to police and partners to deal with the issue effectively and promptly.

You Said...Youth ASB

We Did...We are actively using dispersal and stop search powers where lawful and proportionate, and taking positive action for Youth ASB. Work has continued to identify and visit the parents of Youths responsible for causing an y disruption to our Town.

We Did...Regular patrols and security advice passed on to many stores, working closely with Security in Golden Square to improve safety and security for those working in stores.
