You Said: Complaints regarding anti-social use of e-scooters and illegally modified e-bikes

We Did: City Centre officers have run a number of operations targeting the illegal use of e-scooters and modified e-bikes. During these operations a number of scooters and bikes have been seized and the riders reported for a number of offences relating to driving licences and lack of insurance. More of the operations will be run alongside education explaining the legal status of these scooters/bikes.

You Said: There is anti-social behaviour and street drinking at The Leadworks Lane Park

We Did: A new CCTV Camera, linked to the Cheshire West and Chester CCTV network, has been installed at this location. This enables live footage to be monitored by a CCTV operator, who is linked to the police radio network. Police Officers, Police Community Support Officers and Community Safety Wardens continue to patrol this area. Officers have seized alcohol, searched individuals under the misuse of drugs act, and issued Dispersal Notices to persons causing disorder.
