### **You said-**

Drug activity was impacting the community around Western Avenue, Blacon

### **We Did-**

A Drugs warrant was executed at an address on Western Avenue, drugs were seized and one male who was not the tenant of the property was charged with possession of class A drugs. A partial closure order at the same address was also served. This prevents any persons, other than the tenant from being at the property.

Results from the 27 residence voice surveys completed in August found that the community feel that parking continues to be an issue at a number of locations.
