Frodsham

You Said: Concerns raised by the local community about a number of incidents across the town in recent weeks.

We Did: A Police operation has been set up to specifically target crime in Frodsham. This operation will involve targeted resources to provide a visible presence, acting as a deterrent to those intent on criminality. Residents can support this operation by continuing to provide information to Police either by calling 101 or using the anonymous CrimeStoppers line 0800 555 111.

Chester Villages

You Said: Local officers not visible enough in the community.

We Did: PCSO HANNATH has planned and taken part in a number of community-based events over the summer to provide a high profile, visible presence across the Chester Villages area. He has conducted several 'Street-a-Week' campaigns where he carried out door-to-door enquiries on streets where concerns had been raised about anti-social behaviour. PCSO HANNATH continues to act on information provided to Police via the Resident's Voice system.

Tattenhall & Malpas

You Said: Concerns regarding 'urban explorers' entering a dangerous, abandoned building in a rural area, causing a nuisance to local residents.

We Did: Cheshire Constabulary applied for and obtained a court order, known as a 'closure order', making it a specific offence for any person to enter the building. This has been enforced through targeted deployment of officers to the location and has resulted in a number of arrests.
