Congleton West:

You Said:

The Community raised concerns about anti-social behaviour in Congleton Park.

We Did:

We took action and regularly patrolled this area throughout the summer. Positive action was taken in many circumstances; Including arrests and stop searches. CCTV cameras have also received a full upgrade and are operational throughout the park.

Congleton East:

You Said:

The community raised concerns regard speeding vehicles and vehicles parking in a dangerous manner throughout the ward.

We Did:

We conducted regular speed enforcement checks a various locations and have encouraged the local community to form a "Community Speed Watch group." We will continue to monitor the area for vehicles parking in dangerous manner.

Odd Rode:

You Said:

The community raised concerns regarding speeding vehicles across the ward.

We Did:

We have contacted the local Highways team alongside the Cheshire Constabulary Traffic Management Office after concerns were raised about the danger severity on Newcastle Road (A34). We have commenced a "Community Speed Watch," initiative in the local area.

Alsager:

You Said:

Community concerns were raised around drug misuse in the community.

We Did:

We supported a "Clean up," event with Plus Dane Housing—that sought to improve the local community by cleaning up our open spaces; as well as targeting identified address' involved in criminality / antisocial behaviour. These properties were "closed," and tenants evicted as part of our partnership work to create a safer & stronger community.
