You Said, We Did



Strawberry, Ledsham & Manor

You Said: Residents reported concerns of speeding along Gleneagles Road and Ripon Avenue and parking.

We Did: Officers have visited the area with the speed camera to educate and remind drivers to adhere to the speed limit. Advice has also been provided to residents regarding parking on junctions.

Visits will continue as part of our road safety duties.

St. Pauls

You Said: Recently there have been issues surrounding anti-social behaviour near to Alvanley Road.

We Did: Plain clothed operations have been conducted and several stop searches have been carried out.

Sutton

You Said: Local residents reported drug dealing in a communal block of flats.

We Did: Local beat officers compiled the information provided and applied to the Courts for a Section 8 warrant. This is a warrant which authorises the entry and search of a premises to look for evidence of a criminal offence and to seize any items linked to it.

This warrant was granted and executed. A large amount of drug paraphernalia and controlled drugs were recovered, along with a number of mobile phones.

The tenant was arrested for two offences of Possession with intent to supply and bailed to Court.
