You Said, We Did



Macclesfield North & Poynton

You Said: Residents have raised concerns over the illegal sale of vapes to children.

We Did: An operation was run with the Beat Team, Police Cadets and Trading Standards who conducted test purchases on shops across the area. Thirteen shops were visited, with one shop failing the test purchase and selling to an underage youth.

You Said: Over 450 Residents Voice were completed with residents from Macclesfield North and Poynton in June, July and August. The main concern raised by residents was speeding.

We Did: The Beat Team conducted over 10 hours of enforcement. Twenty six drivers were found to be exceeding the speed limit and will be prosecuted or given the opportunity to attend a driver improvement scheme.

You Said: Police are to focus on vehicle crime.

We Did: A Land Rover Discovery was stolen from an address in Disley without keys in October 2023, it was later discovered in Staffordshire. A complex investigation followed and it transpired that the vehicle had been sold to a second-hand car firm on false plates. The officer traced the sale back to a male who was subsequently arrested. Further investigation provided evidence to the handling of the stolen car and in August 2024 the male was charged by CPS for handling stolen goods.

You Said: There are concerns of drug dealing and county lines .

We Did: In August 2023 a vehicle was stopped entering Poynton. The two occupants and the vehicle was searched. A large amount of drugs and money was recovered. Following an in depth investigation the CPS have recently authorised that the two occupants are to be charged with possession of class A drugs with intent to supply.
