MARBURY

You Said: Parking on Hall Lane Wincham

We Did: Regular patrols of the area and fixed penalty notices issued when vehicles have been obstructing the highway. Spoke to the site manager who will be addressing the situation with staff.

You Said: Report of vehicles parking anti-socially within the ward at Local Schools in the area.

We Did: Regular patrols have been conducted at Schools within the ward - Schools have been advised to report any parking complaints to Op Park Safe online.

WINNINGTON & CASTLE

You Said: Youths being anti-social within the ward area. Playing knock and run, climbing derelict buildings and being disrespectful to members of the community.

We Did: CSW Cliff and I have attended two primary schools and conducted Crime and Consequences talks with year 6 explaining the impact of their behaviour on the wider community. We discussed the age of criminal responsibility, stop and search, being arrested and how to make better choices.

WEAVER & CUDDINGTON

You Said: Parking was a concern on East Lane, Moss Lane, Russet Road and Norley Road Cuddington .

We Did: Parking controls on several occasions, no offences witnessed.

You Said: Speed was a concern on Norley Road, The Spinney, Iris Rise.

We Did : Community speed watch volunteers monitored / observed all locations. Drivers caught exceeding speed limits were sent warning letters.

You Said: Speed was a concern on High Street Weaverham.

We Did: Speed enforcement was carried out on High Street Weaverham ,no offences captured.
