You Said, We Did



Halton Brook

You Said:

Residents reported an increase in anti social behaviour and drug dealing in the area of the shops on Meadway.

We Did:

This area has been subject to an increase in policing presence, with officers patrolling the area regularly on foot for at least 15 minutes. This has led to almost a complete reduction in reports of anti social behaviour in this area. A warrant has also been executed in an address opposite the shops, where a quantity of cannabis was found and two people have been arrested for being concerned in the supply of drugs.

The Grange

You Said:

Increase in shoplifting offences from Herons foods.

We Did:

Prolific shoplifter was identified and arrested for numerous thefts, he has since received a custodial sentence.

Halton Lea

You Said:

Repeated reports of anti social behaviour on the busways and local bus stations.

We Did:

We have an increased presence on the busways, including plain clothes on the local buses. We have been working with local schools to educate youths on the impact their behaviour may have on staff and the public.

Heath and Beechwood

You Said: Residents reported concerns about XL bully type bulldogs escaping from an address causing distress to local residents, who were concerned that the dogs may attack someone.

We Did: Police have attended this address, along with the forces dog handler unit and the. Dogs have been removed and re-homed to a more secure location.

Old Town/Mersey

You Said:

Ongoing issues with parking in Church Street

We Did:

Increased patrolling in the area, which has resulted in education being given to drivers. Fixed penalty notices have been issued to those persistent offenders
