You Said, We Did



Sandbach Town.

You Said:

The community raised concerns relating to a visible policing presence in the town to tackle anti social behaviour.

We Did:

Beat officers have increased their foot patrols in the town, particularly on market days. This provided the officers with an excellent opportunity to connect with members of the public in an informal setting.

Middlewich

You Said:

The community raised concerns about anti-social behaviour, specifically in the Town centre area.

We Did:

Beat officers have collated the information and patrolled the areas at identified times. Youths causing issues have been spoken to with parents / guardians and issued behavioural notices through Cheshire East Council.

Dane Valley.

You Said:

The community raised concerns regarding speeding vehicles in the ward.

We Did:

We have trained volunteers from the local community who have re-established a "Community speed watch group." The group are now completing regular monitoring activity at specific locations to improve road safety.

Ettiley Heath & Wheelock.

You Said:

The community raised concerns relating to traffic matters in the ward area.

We Did:

Conducted visible patrols and deployed "Tru Cam," at identified locations, as well as working with local authority partners, to improve roadside signage in the area educating road users.
