As we move in to the second Quarter of 2024 we continue to focus on key community issues that you have highlighted to us – the same themes emerge around Road Safety and Anti-Social behaviour causing issues within our communities and our teams are committed to ensuring action continues, they work tirelessly to keep our communities safe and we will look to maximise our social media engagement so that you can keep up to date with the latest action and changes.

In March we undertook a neighbourhood week of action in which we; closed a prolific house causing ASB to communities, seized 14 off road motorcycles being used in anti-social behaviour and drugs supply, arrested 9 youths in the town for a violent disorder and seized an assortment of drugs and weapons for several warrants executed. This is part and parcel of the work we do everyday, but just a reminder to communities that we are here and tough on criminals, albeit not everything we do we publish on social media.

Our approach to anti-social behaviour and those causing misery to our estates is robust – and we rely on your information and intelligence to feed our neighbourhood teams to ensure that we keep Warrington safe – please complete our Residents Voice survey monthly and help determine how we police OUR communities.

You Said, We Did



Fairfield and Howley

You Said: You asked the police to continue to target Drug Dealing in specific alleyways on Howley/Fairfield.

You asked for more Police Presence on the streets.

You asked for more police speeding enforcement.

We Did: Street of the week have been conducted in the local area gathering intelligence and Residents Voice opinions.

Op Sideline has been committed to patrolling the local areas with Police Officers on foot patrol.

An arrest has been made regarding drug activity in the local area.

The police speed camera has been out of action but other speed deterrence have been conducted on several specific streets on Howley/Fairfield.

Latchford East

You Said: You asked the Police to look at the issue of Parking, Speeding and off-road Bikes on Westy Park, Latchford Village and Kingsway South.

We Did: Parking issues have been looked at around the Westy Lane and Steers Close area. Several advisory notices have been issued asking drivers to be more considerate when parking.

Due to high visibility patrols around school time, advisories have been issued to two motorists who pulled up on zig-zags.

Over 12 individual pieces of Intelligence have been submitted regarding the use of off-road bikes and electric bikes such as Surons. We are still developing our intelligence picture and will be looking to make Latchford East a hostile place for off-road bikes. #OpScrambler

Latchford West

You Said: You asked the Police to continue to target Drug Dealing in the alleyways and parks in Latchford West.

You asked the Police to save lives by preventing and deterring speeding motorists. Making the streets of Warrington a safe place to be.

We Did: Three Street of the Months have been conducted in relation to gathering intelligence and Residence Voice opinions.

Hot-spot patrolling of parks by uniformed officers to reassure the community.

Work is still ongoing in targeting those committing drugs crimes. Any information can be private messaged in confidence to Latchford West Police on Facebook.

Although one of our Speed Cameras has been out of action, further speed deterrence has been conducted on Gainsborough Road, Loushers Lane, Chester Road and Knutsford Road.

Police action on Dangerous and/or Unnecessary Obstruction has occurred on Gainsborough Road and Meadow Avenue.

Bewsey and Whitecross

You Said: You asked us to target drug use and drug dealing in the Bewsey and Whitecross area

You told us that there is an issue with careless and inconsiderate parking causing a danger to pedestrians and other road users in several streets in Bewsey and Whitecross

Some residents reported anti-social behaviour from neighbouring addresses having a detrimental effect on their lives

We Did: We have conducted 3 warrants under the misuse of drugs act as a result of intelligence from the community. We will continue to take positive action when we receive credible intelligence about drug supply from the community.

We have continued to target hotspot areas for parking complaints and have issued a number of fixed penalty tickets to illegally parked vehicles.

We have conducted a number of joint visits with Torus housing to tackle anti social behaviour as well as a number of home visits to youths and their parents where they have been identified as being involved in ASB. A number of off road and electric bikes have also been seized across Warrington
