You Said: Drug activity across Warrington East

We Did: Over 20 stop searches have been conducted. As a result of these, there have been a number of arrests and referrals made.

You Said: Underage selling of alcohol

We Did: Joint agency test purchasing visits were conducted with Licensing Officers at a number of shops across Warrington East to tackle the sale of alcohol to people under the age. One premises received a community resolution, part of which they must undertake an educational licensing training input.

You Said: Speeding on Glover Road, Warrington Road, Padgate Lane, Hillock Lane

We Did: Warrington East Team have conducted speed monitoring sessions across 20 sites including the roads mentioned in the past quarter. Out of these 20 sites, 51 sessions have been completed.

We want to thank those drivers who continue to watch your speed and drive within the limits. However, across these sessions, there are still some vehicles that have been observed exceeding the prescribed limits. We want to remind everyone of the importance of adhering to the prescribed speed limits – slow down saves lives.

You Said: More visibility

We Did: We have held weekly surgeries, including mobile surgeries where the public can come and discuss any issues. During some of these sessions we have also provided free bike marking, where we have marked 14 bikes.

We have also attended various community events including Dr Bike which have taken place across different locations in Warrington East. The Dr Bike events are multi-agency sessions with WBC to check the safety, maintenance and conditions of the bikes along with bike marking, all provided free of charge.
