You Said, We Did



Sped concerns on Hollins Lane

You Said: Residents raised concerns regarding speeding vehicles on Hollins Lane, Winwick

We Did: Enforcement has been carried out on a regular basis at the location, drivers found to be in excess of the speed limit have been reported for the offence and will either be issued a £100 fixed penalty with 3 points, offered a driver awareness course or summoned to court.

Safer streets zone outside St Philips CE school

You Said: Concerns over parking outside St Philips CE school at drop off/pick up times.

We Did: Working with partner agencies and the school, a vehicle free zone has been introduced at the location during school drop off/pick up times, the road outside the school becomes a pedestrian and cycling only zone

Three arrested for drug offences.

You Said: Concerns raised over drug dealing on Finsbury Close.

We Did: A warrant was executed at an address on Finsbury Close after residents raised concerns, 3 individual's were arrested at the scene in connection with several drug offences.

Underage sale.

You Said: Residents raised concerns of underage sales at licenced premises.

We Did: Officers attended several premises on the Warrington West area and conducted a test purchasing operation.

5 of the premises failed the test purchases by selling to a person under 18 years old. Staff at these premises have been retrained in the Challenge 25 programme.
