BROADHEATH

You Said: Off Road Bikes, Drug dealing, ASB

We Did:

- Local offender brought to justice and charged with offences relating to off road bikes, drug dealing and anti-social behaviour.
- A number of 'Ring' doorbells provided free of charge to local residents in the area who have been subjected to repeated ASB or identified as being vulnerable victims.
- Multi Agency visits with local partners targeting victims of anti-social behavior to offer support and advise.. This has led to a reduction in incidents in key areas.

HOUGH GREEN

You Said: Drug Dealing and ASB Issues

We Did:

- We gathered information about a cannabis farm on Brookdale and executed a successful warrant at the address.. One male arrested and charged with cultivation of cannabis.
- High Visibility in the area of Bechers shops and Grizedale. One male arrested for the offence of possession with intent to supply Class B Cannabis.
- Working with local council authority target hardening the area in regards to reducing off road bikes.
- A number of 'Ring' doorbells provided free of charge to local residents in the area who have been subjected to repeated ASB or identified as being vulnerable victims.

HALTON VIEW

You Said: Drugs and ASB issue,

We Did:

- Report of 'cuckooing' in the Norlands Street area. Area visited, reassurance given and safe guarding for the victim. One male reported for breach of a community behavior order.
- New PC in post covering the Halton View Area. PC Dan Butler.

FARNWORTH

You Said: Off Road Motorcycles/ ASB

We Did:

- Operation TORRID is in place to record and combat the issue of Off Road bikes. Places of issue include the Bongs, Police have conducted a number of Hi Vis and plain clothes deployments, resulting in a number of seizures and sec 59 warning notices being issued.
- Monitoring parking on Derby Road (ongoing), working with partnership agencies to remove abandoned vehicles and issuing tickets/advice to illegally parked vehicles.

BIRCHFIELD

You Said: ASB / Parking

We Did:

- PCSO conducted patrols specifically to identify issues around inconsiderate parking. It was identified that the issues come due to poor planning when the estate was built as the houses do not accommodate more than two vehicle parking, There are no road markings on the estate to enforce. Highways are aware of this problem. In the event that parking is causing an obstruction Police will continue to attend.

DITTON & HALE

You Said: Speeding

We Did:

- You told us of speeding and HGV's parking on pavements on Everite Road.
- We carried out enforcement (ongoing) advising local companies.
