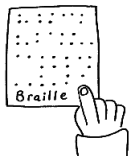

Hate crime may be when someone:



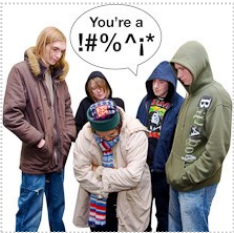
Bullies or frightens you
